

# The Birth of Yeshua

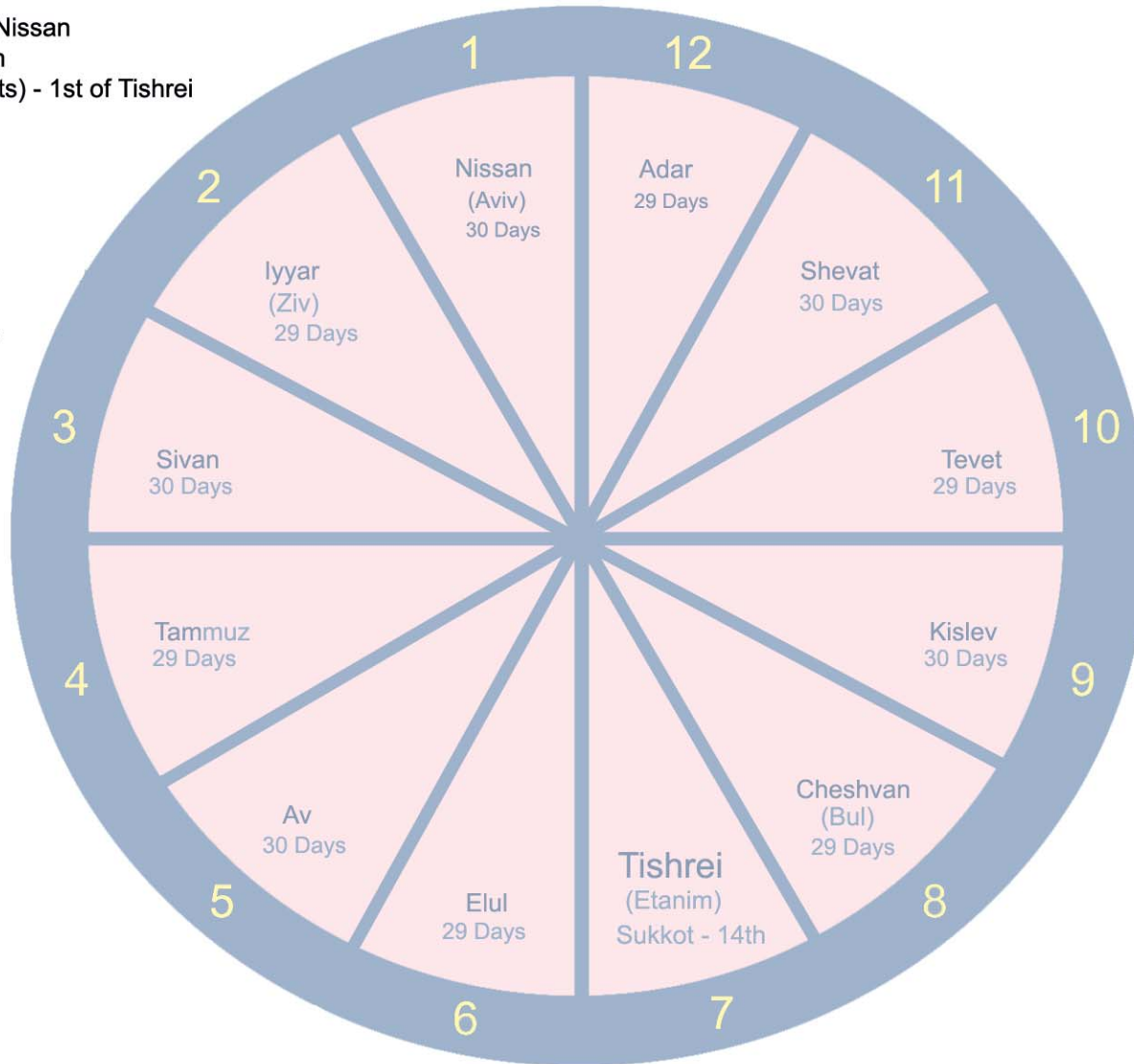
Passover (Pesach) is the 14th of Nissan  
 Pentecost (Shavuot) - 6th of Sivan  
 Rosh Hashannah (Day of Trumpets) - 1st of Tishrei  
 Yom Kippur - 10th of Tishrei  
 Sukkot - 14th of Tishrei  
 Hanukkah - 25th of Kislev

Elizabeth was in her 6th month of pregnancy (Shevat) when Mary's pregnancy began (Luke 1:26-36).

The 8th Course of "Abijah" begins the second half of the month of Tammuz (1 Chronicles 24:1-10).

From the "24 Courses" established for the priesthood to serve in the Temple (two each month), Zachariah went in to serve according to his course, in the lineage of "Abijah," the eighth course (Luke 1:5-8).

Zachariah finished his two-week course of service, returned home and Elizabeth became pregnant potentially in the month of Av (Luke 1:23-24).



And the Word became flesh and dwelt (tabernacled [a Sukkah]) among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth (John 1:14).
